## ABOUT THE SPEAKERS

### Professor Pierre Tercier

Professor Pierre Tercier is Chairman of the ICC International Court of Arbitration.

A Swiss national and professor at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, Professor Tercier has extensive international arbitration and dispute resolution experience, having served on numerous occasions in ICC, ICSID and other cases. He is highly respected in the international legal and business community as an arbitrator, lecturer and author. Professor Tercier formerly chaired the Swiss Cartel Commission and the Swiss Insurance Law Society.

Professor Tercier is a visiting professor of law at numerous universities, including Geneva and Paris. He graduated from the University of Fribourg *summa cum laude* and was admitted to the Bar in 1969. In 2004, he was awarded an honorary doctorate by the University of Paris II.

### Mr Jason Fry

Mr Jason Fry has been a member of the ICC International Court of Arbitration for seven years, representing New Zealand, and will be joining the Secretariat of the ICC Court full time in his new position as Secretary General. He has been a partner at the law firm of Clifford Chance in Paris since 1999. Mr Fry will officially assume his duties on 1 November.

### Ms Anne Marie Whitesell

Ms Anne Marie Whitesell is Senior Strategy Adviser to the ICC International Court of Arbitration. She has over ten years' experience with the ICC Court, most recently as Secretary General (2001–2007), prior to which she was successively Counsel and Deputy Secretary General.

Ms Whitesell received her J.D. from the University of Virginia School of Law and her Doctorate in law from the Université de Paris I, Panthéon-Sorbonne. She is admitted to the New York State Bar and to the United States District Courts for the Southern and Eastern Districts of New York. She has practised with law firms in the United States and in France and was a lecturer at the Université de Paris I, Panthéon-Sorbonne and the Institut de Droit Comparé (Université de Paris II).

### Mr Chan Leng Sun

Mr Chan Leng Sun is the Chairman of the ADR Committee of the Singapore Law Society. He is a Fellow, Tutor and Council Member of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators. He is also a Fellow of the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators. Leng Sun is in the Panel of Arbitrators of the Singapore Institute of Arbitrators and the Law Society Arbitration Scheme. He is the SIAC Observer to the UNCITRAL working session on arbitration.
